Snowflakes Pretzel Pops

Ingredients

- bright white candy melts
- mini pretzels
- white sprinkles
- lollipop sticks
- disposable decorating bag
- EZ Thins (optional)

Directions:

Line a baking tray with wax paper and set aside. In a microwave-safe bowl, pour 1 cup of candy melts (and a sprinkle of EZ Thins, if using). Microwave at 70 percent power for 90 seconds. Stir and continue to microwave until the candy melts are mostly melted. Stir, using the residual heat to completely melt the candy. Drop a pretzel in the melted candy, and remove resting on a fork. Bang the fork on the side of the bowl to remove excess chocolate and place on the baking tray. Sprinkle with the white sprinkles. Candy melts set quickly, so add sprinkles every two or three pretzels. One cup of candy melts should cover about 20 pretzels, or 5 finished snowflakes. Let set well.
